Title: Network Engineer

GENERAL SUMMARY:

The Network Engineer will be responsible for the installation and maintenance of all company networks and systems on property and at offsite locations. This position will be working within the Gaming Industry, knowledge of regulatory requirements for Class II and Class III gaming is a plus. The Network Engineer will be responsible for design, configuring, maintenance, and installation of secure server systems including mobile and wireless platforms.

The Network Engineer will work closely with the development team to create and implement internal and external IT/MIS solutions. This position has a variety of duties and a wide range of technical knowledge is needed. Additional duties include configuring employee computers and troubleshooting any hardware or software issues that may occur, and assisting with gaming equipment.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Design, configure, install and troubleshoot various network devices and services (routers, switches, firewalls, VPN, wireless equipment etc.) for network security and topology
- Perform network maintenance and system upgrades including hot fixes, service and security upgrades
- Provide support and troubleshooting to resolve issues
- Research and select security tools, policies, and procedures in connection with the customer's needs
- Work with vendors and IT personnel for problem solving resolution and upgrades
- Configure and define parameters for installation or testing of local area network (LAN), wide area network (WAN), hubs, routers, switches, controllers, multiplexers, or related networking equipment
- Configure and maintain UNIX and Windows servers
- Maintenance & Support set up for systems, networks, computers
- Business mail client; G Suite is a plus
- Backup management – cloud / on site
- Test computer software and hardware using standard diagnostic testing for go live implementation
- Maintain logs of network activity and provide customer support related to networking and connectivity issues



- Train users in procedures regarding networking applications.
- Experience with the coordination and implementation of computer and peripheral systems, to include planning, specifications development, purchasing, installation, training, troubleshooting and repair
- Self-motivated with the ability to effectively prioritize and execute tasks
- Prepare and monitor disaster recovery
